How to get to UCLA and the lab from LAX:

Using public transit (the bus):

Once you land, follow the signs for ground transport to exit to the curb.

Look for the pink colored pylons where you can catch the shuttle bus to the City Bus Center. It arrives every 15-35 minutes.

Get off at the CBC; if you have a dollar bill, that's what you'll need to get on the bus. It just costs \$1. If you want to ride public transit more or don't have cash, you can buy a real TAP card at the vending machine at the CBC or add one to your Apple or Android phone via this link:

Walk to the Culver City 6 bus stop (CC6, or CC6R) section at the CBC, indicated by a green sign.

The bus will say UCLA on the front when it comes if it is the right one.

Get on the bus and ride for around an hour until it reaches its last stop which is UCLA.

Get off the bus and walk to Terasaki Life Sciences Building (5-10 minute walk); you can use Google Maps to find us or download and print the PDF version of the map.

Using a taxi or a rideshare:

Walk to the green colored Pylons and wait for the LAX-it shuttle bus that will take you to the area where taxis are waiting for you and where you can meet a Lyft or Uber.

Depending on the traffic, Lyft or Uber will cost \$35-55 usually.

Taxis usually cost at least 20% more.
